REPORT OF THE ASSOCIATION PRESIDENT APRIL 11, 2015

The Capital District Tenpin Bowling Association (CDTBA) has completed year eleven as a charter association of the Canadian Tenpin Federation, Inc. (CTF). During the past year, CTF was granted Non-Profit Corporation status by Corporations Canada. Due to this new status, a bowler with a CTF card will now be known as a "Registered Bowler" or a "Registered Participant".

For the CDTBA's Board of Directors, the 2014-2015 bowling season has been an active year filled with standard association business, services, activities and is operating as is customary.

The goal of the Board of Directors is to continue to improve, identify and initiate programs and procedures to allow our Association to be responsive to its valued bowlers. We are proud of our bowlers, their camaraderie and accomplishments. Many friendships have started while volunteering or bowling in a league or tournament. I encourage you to help our sport grow by inviting family and friends to bowl.

In 2014-2015, registered bowlers in this association numbered 397 bowlers, a 12% decrease compared to last season. For next season, the Board will look into a plan to retain and increase participation.

Each season, the CDTBA Local Association Awards Program recognizes men, women and youth in the categories of high scratch game, high scratch series, high average and most improved bowler. Our new "Honor Board", at McArthur Lanes, also recognizes bowler accomplishments.

Tournaments

CDTBA-CTF11th Annual Handicap Mixed Tournament - February 28th, March 1st, 7th and 8th.

Members were emailed and posters displayed for this tournament resulting in 191 entries (59 Singles, 36 Doubles and 15 Teams). Great turn out for this event.

CDTBA-CTF 11th Annual Handicap Youth Tournament - February 21st.

Entries were 13 singles and 12 doubles. The CDTBA provided the winners with gift certificates to a total value of \$340.00. Our Youth Co-ordinator Ray Bullard was the Tournament Director.

3rd Annual Road to the "Big Win" Tournament Series

This tournament series ran throughout the season and was comprised of seven tournaments with a variety of formats. Between 36 and 48 bowlers participated is each tournament resulting in a total prize fund payout for the series of over \$4,300.00. As requested by our bowlers, we plan to have a similar tournament series next season.

Tournament 50/50 Draw – Youth Contribution

During the adult association tournament and during league nights we ran a 50/50 draw. The proceeds of \$210.00 went to the Youth Program to assist with expenses to send bowlers to the Youth Provincial Championships in May 2015. Thank you for supporting our youth bowlers.

Lane Inspections and Certifications

Since the Association owns the equipment necessary to conduct lane inspections, we conduct the lane inspections in-house. For the 2014-2015 season, McArthur Lanes and Quille-O-Drome Galaxie were inspected. A number of CDTBA Board members volunteered to participate in the inspections.

OTBA Awards

The following two awards are given by the Ontario Tenpin Bowling Association. Both awards are once in a lifetime and the bowler must have bowled two thirds of the league season.

-Series Century Award – Travel Alarm/Calculator for 100 pins over average in a series for bowlers with a 175 and below average.

-200 game Award – Folding Tote Bag for 200 game for bowlers with a 140 and below average. Some leagues did not submit award applications for their bowlers.

Celebrating the 2014-2015 Season – April 11, 2015

The day will consist of the Final "Big Win" Tournament, the CDTBA Annual General Meeting, the Annual Tournament Payout and light refreshments.

CDTBA Board Meetings

The Board of Directors are all volunteers elected from the Association's bowlers and meet approximately once a month. The Association has always had an "open door policy". In general, all association bowlers are welcome to attend regularly scheduled CDTBA Board meetings.

The CDTBA can have nine elected board members. This year we operated with a full board. The association needs to have a full board of an effective composition and size to adequately perform responsibilities, duties, be responsive to our bowlers, implement new programs and move forward. If the same people serve year after year, there is no way for new blood and new ideas to come to the board. In a time of rapid change, the presence of new people who bring a new perspective will promote creativity and innovation in board decision-making and the association's future.
