REPORT OF THE ASSOCIATION PRESIDENT TO THE CDTBA ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING APRIL 14, 2018

The Capital District Tenpin Bowling Association (CDTBA) has completed year fourteen as a charter association of the Canadian Tenpin Federation (CTF). For the CDTBA's Board of Directors, the 2017-2018 bowling season has been an active year filled with standard association business, services, activities and is operating as is customary.

The goal of the Board of Directors is to continue to improve, identify and initiate programs and procedures to allow our Association to be responsive to its valued members. We are proud of our members, their camaraderie and accomplishments. Many friendships have started while volunteering or bowling in a league or tournament. I encourage you to help our sport grow by inviting family and friends to bowl with you.

In 2017-18, the Association registered bowlers numbered 291 bowlers, a 7.0% decrease compared to last season.

Some noteworthy activities of the Association for the 2017-18 season:

• Local Association Awards Program

Each season, the CDTBA Local Association Awards Program recognizes men, women and youth in the categories of high scratch game, high scratch series, high average and most improved bowler. Our honor board at McArthur Lanes recognizes bowler accomplishments, which this past year has recognized Rosalie Hiscock for highest female average throughout Ontario.

• Lane Inspections and Certifications

The Association owns the equipment necessary to conduct lane inspections and conducts lane inspections at McArthur Lanes and Quille-O-Drome Galaxie. A number of CDTBA Board members volunteered to participate in lane inspections for the 2017-18 season; Quille-O-Drome Galaxie and McArthur Lanes were inspected. Quille-O-Drome Galaxie and McArthur were conditional, pending resubmission for full certification.

Tournaments

CDTBA-CTF 14th Annual Handicap Mixed Tournament

This tournament took place on February 24, 25 and March 3, 4 2018.

Members were emailed and posters displayed for this tournament resulting in 129 entries (35 Singles, 28 Doubles and 12 Teams) which represents a %50 increase from last year. It should be noted, the CDTBA contributed \$15 to each participants first entry (56 entries).

CDTBA-CTF 14th Annual Handicap Youth Tournament

This tournament took place on February 24, 2018. The CDTBA provided the winners with gift certificates for a total value of \$340.00. The Tournament Director is Dan Litten.

Other Tournaments

As requested by the membership, BIG WIN TOURNAMENT #6 was held this season. These tournaments were well attended.

Tournament 50/50 Draws

During the adult association tournament and during league nights we ran 50/50 draws. The proceeds of \$200.00 went to the Youth Program to assist with expenses to send bowlers to the Youth Provincial Championships in May 2018. Thank you for supporting our youth bowlers.

OTBA Awards

The following two awards are given by the Ontario Tenpin Bowling Federation. Both awards are once in a lifetime and the bowler must have bowled two thirds of the league season.

Series Century Award – cell phone/key chain for 100 hundred pins over average in a series for bowlers with 175 average and below.

200 Game Award – a folding tote bag for 200 game bowlers with a 140 average and below.

Some leagues did not submit any award applications for their bowlers.
